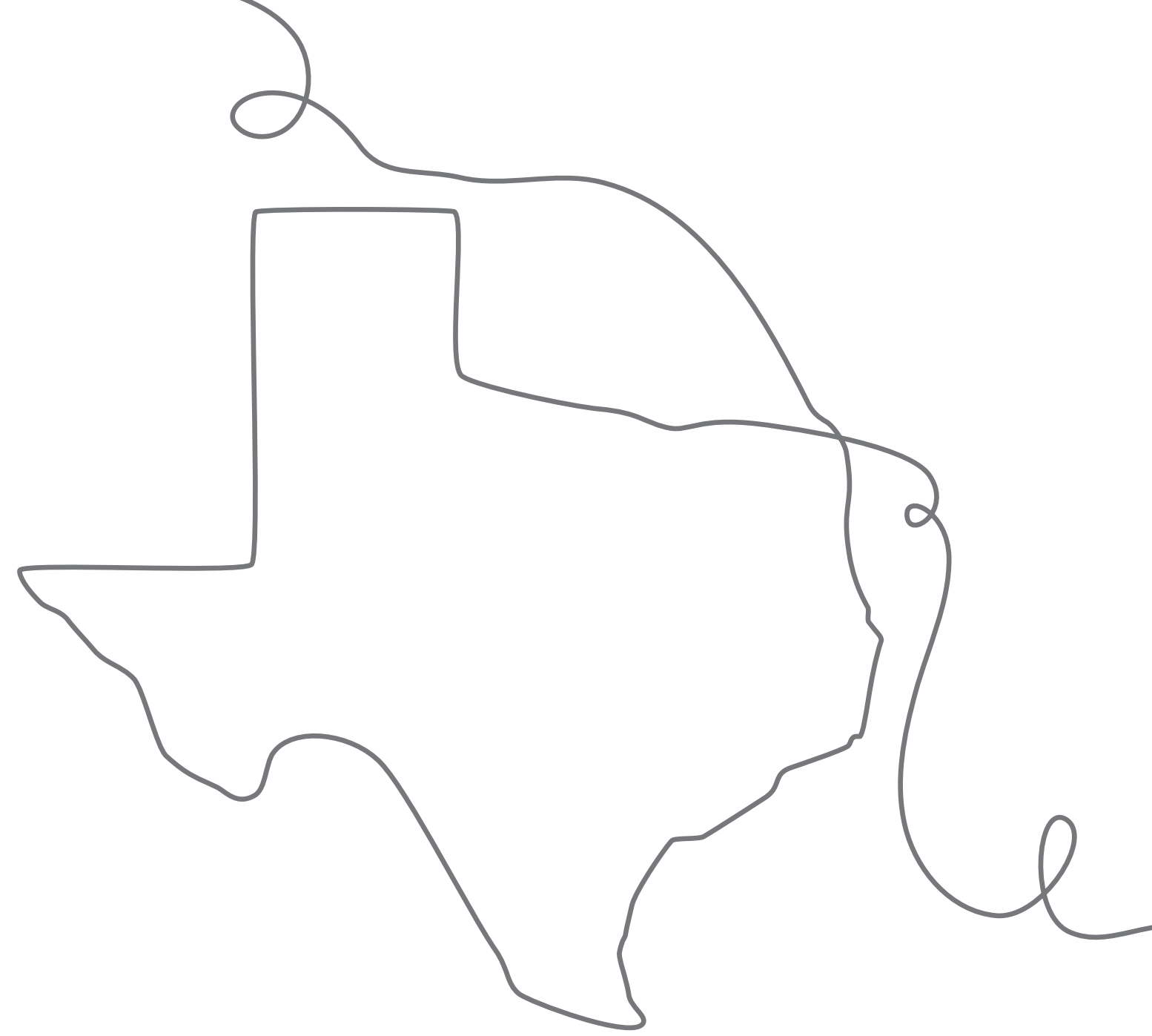

Depending on your classroom configuration, you may need to have students sit closer to the flip book in order to see the images clearly.







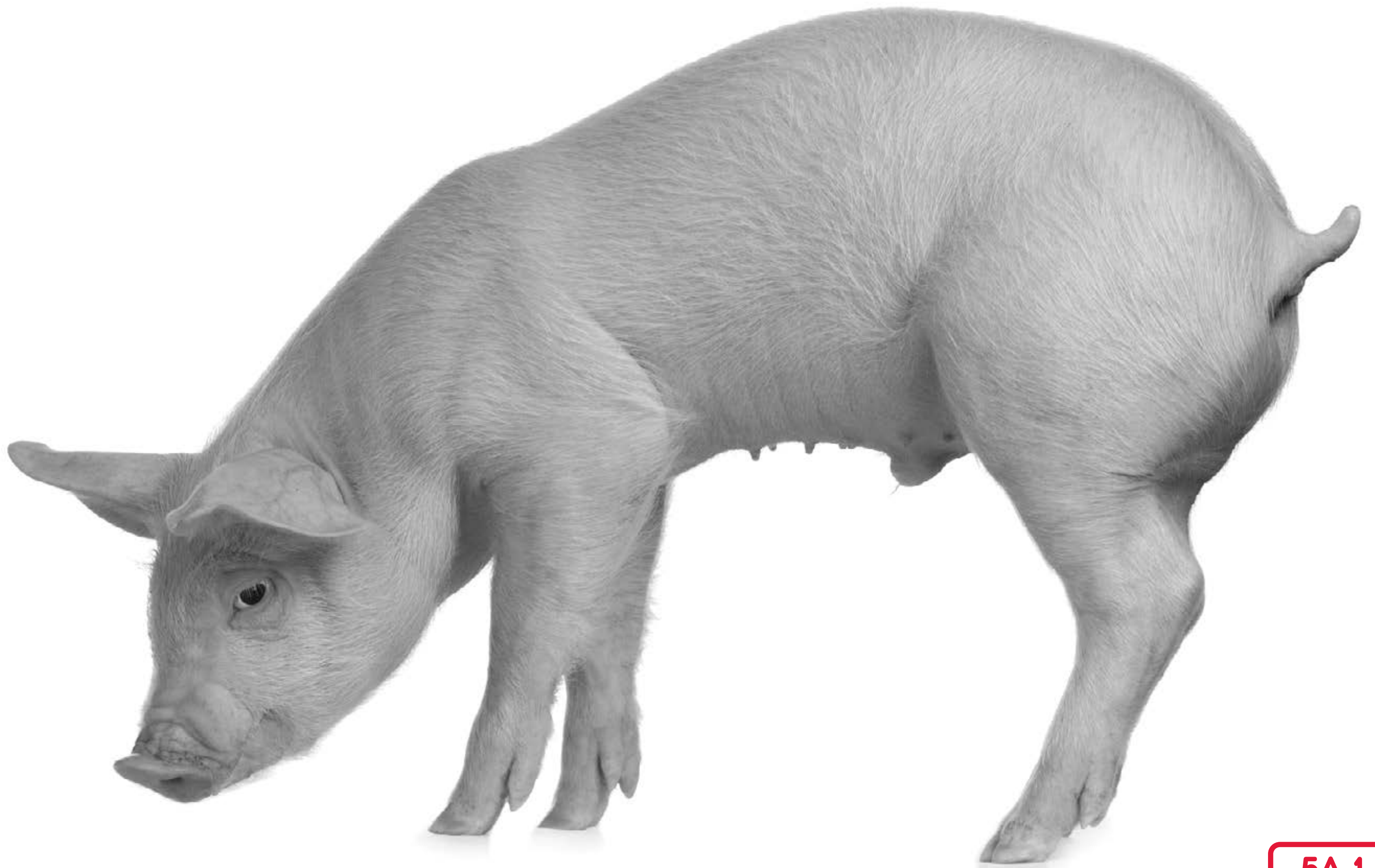














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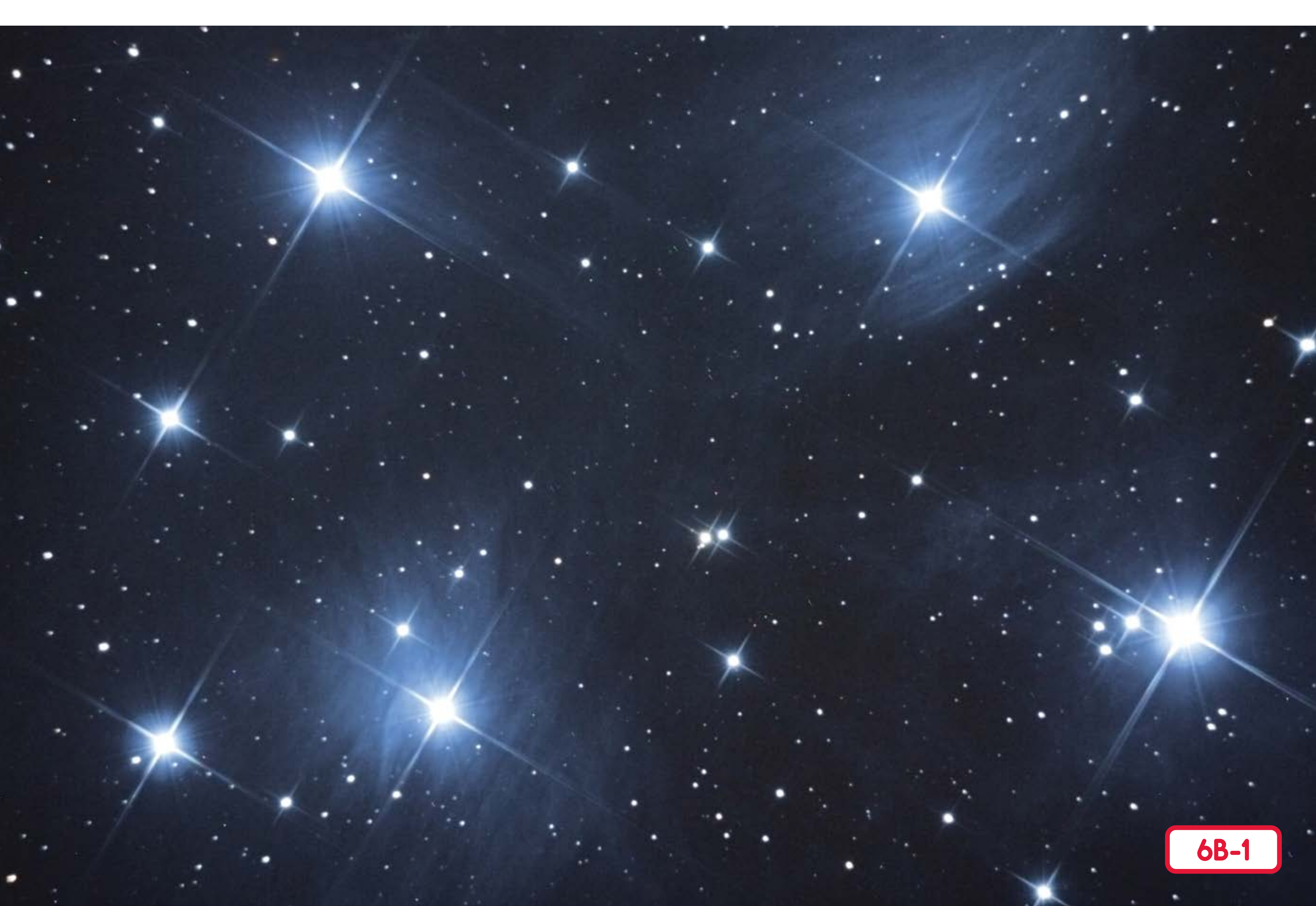
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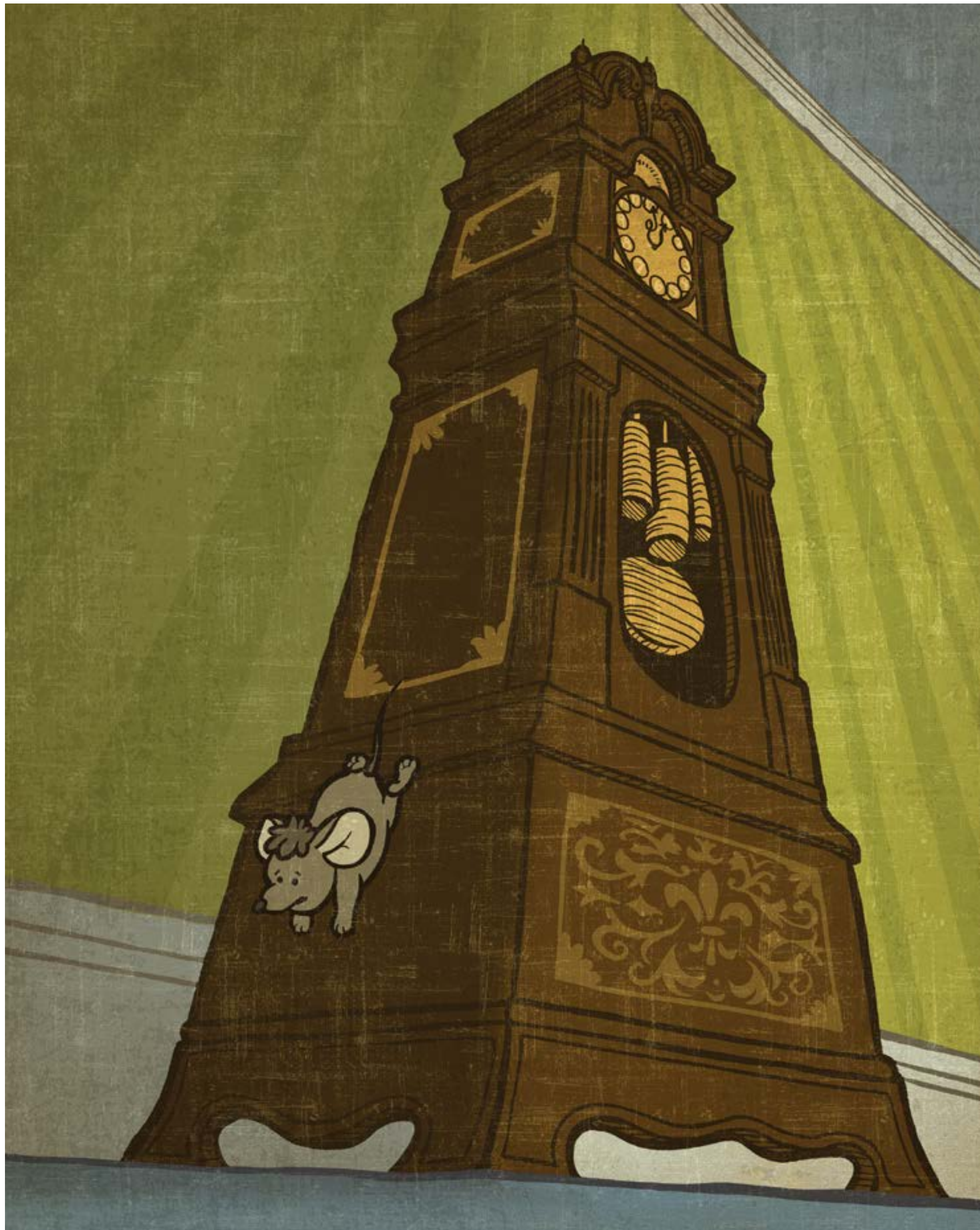

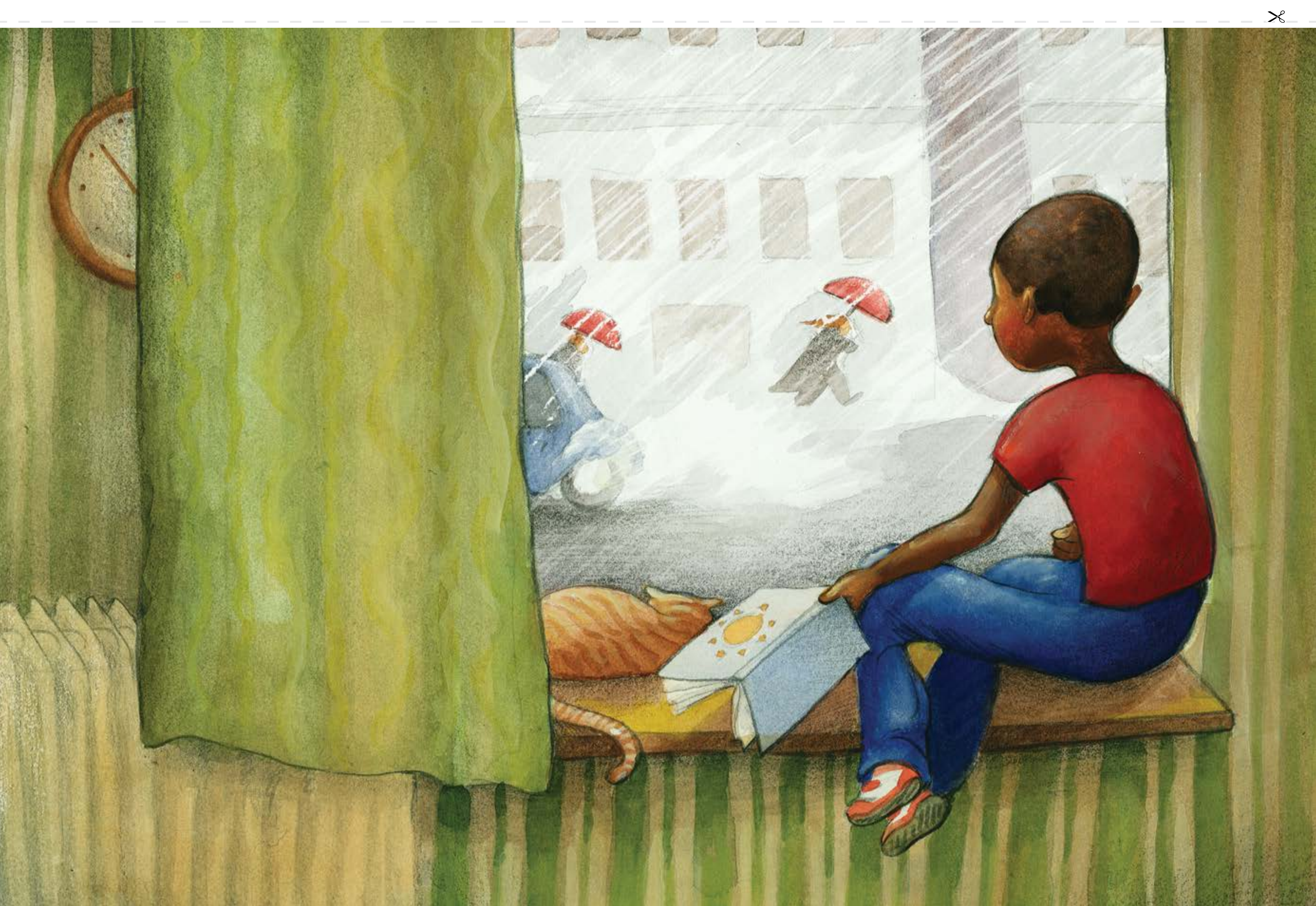
Poster 1 of 18 : Roses Are Red

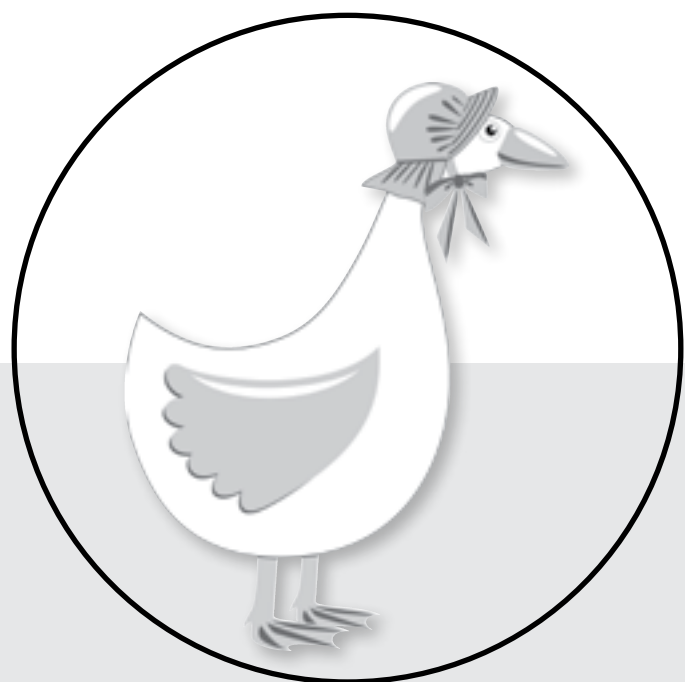

Poster 2 of 18 : Ring Around the Rosie

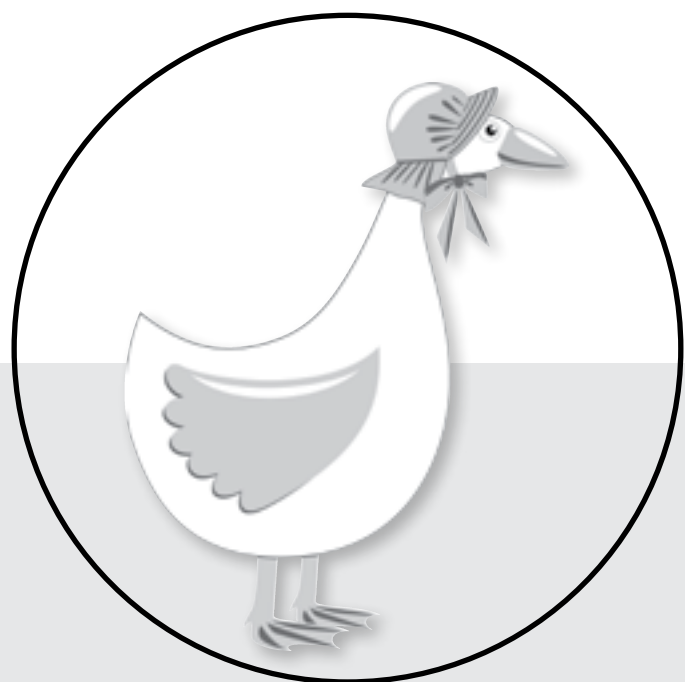

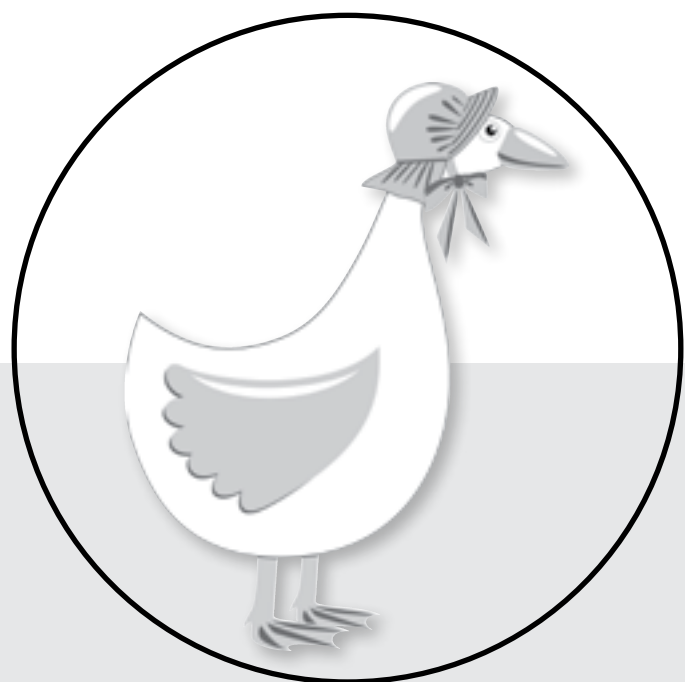

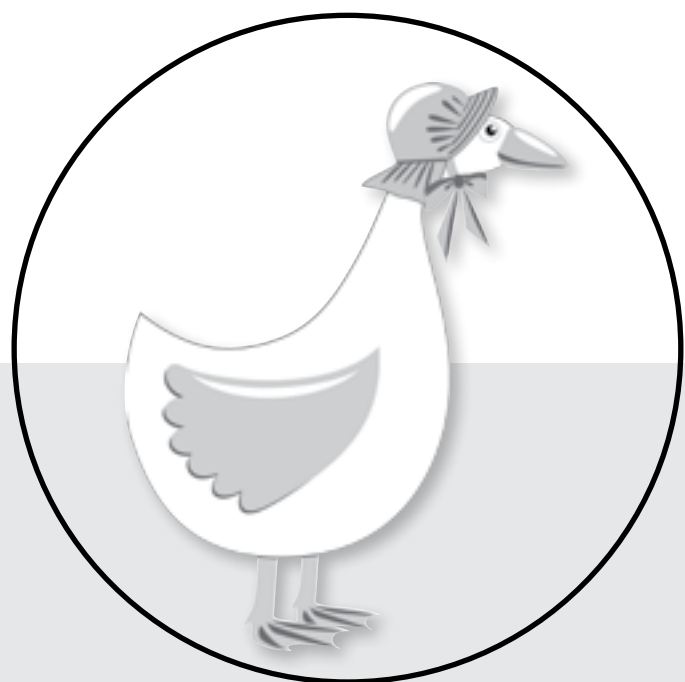

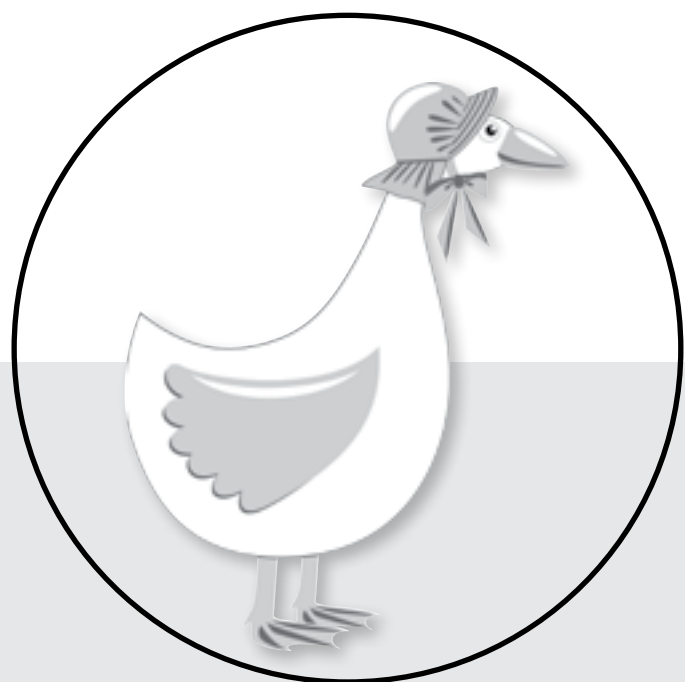

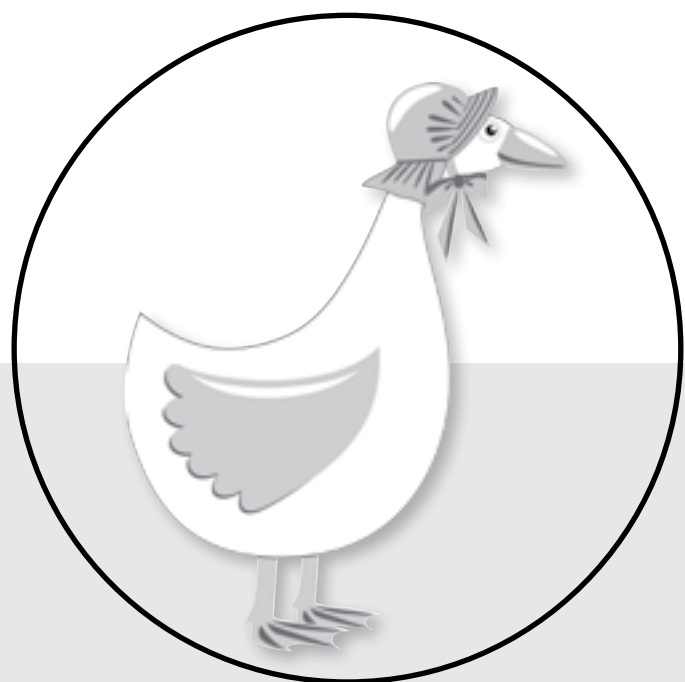

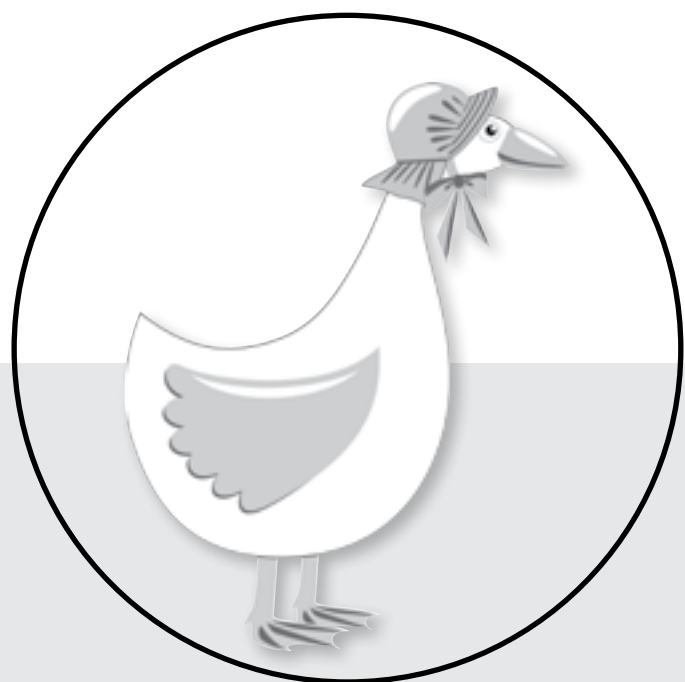

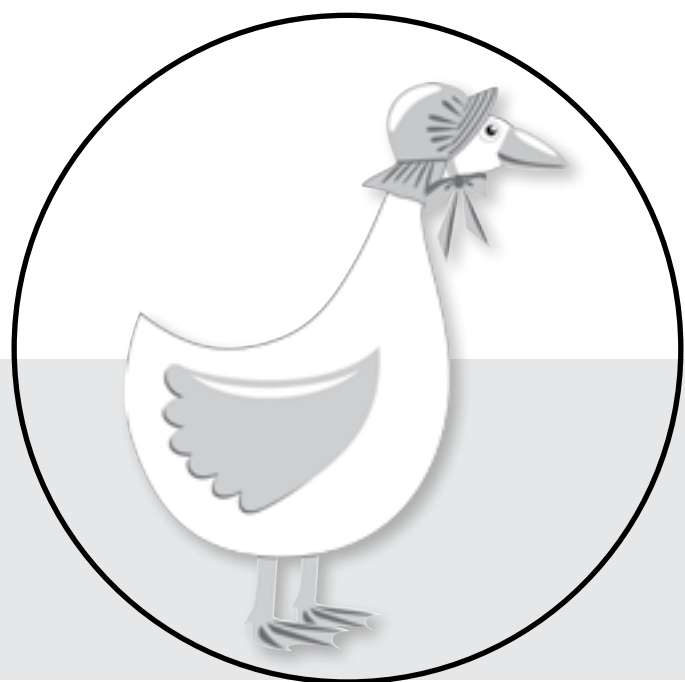

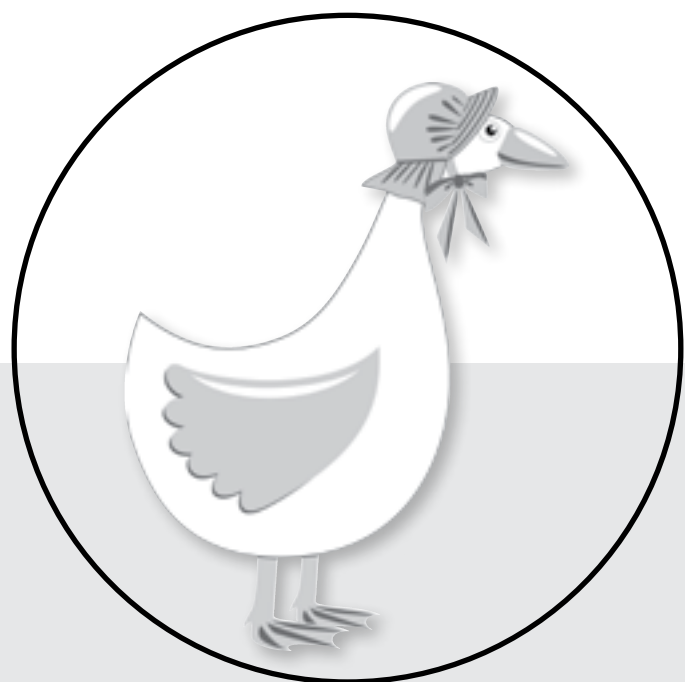

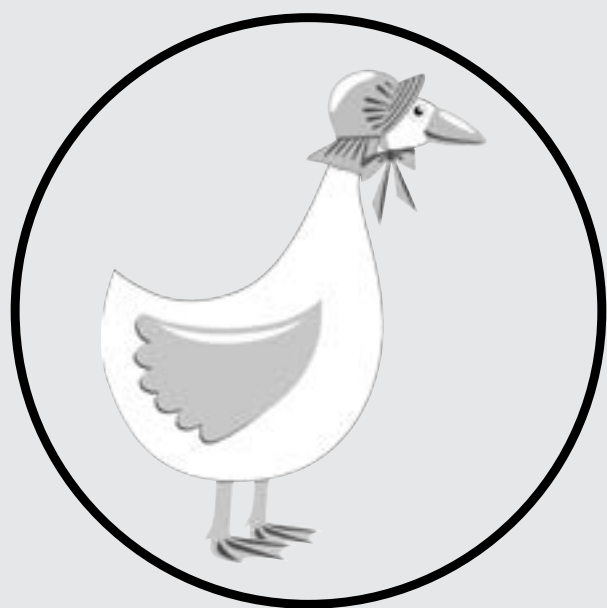


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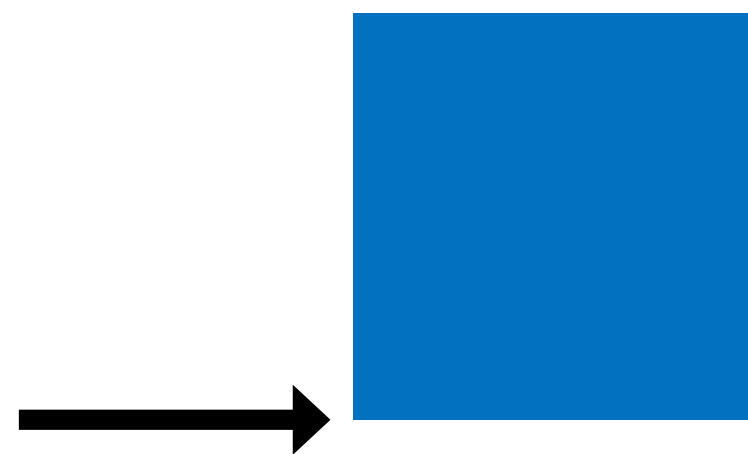
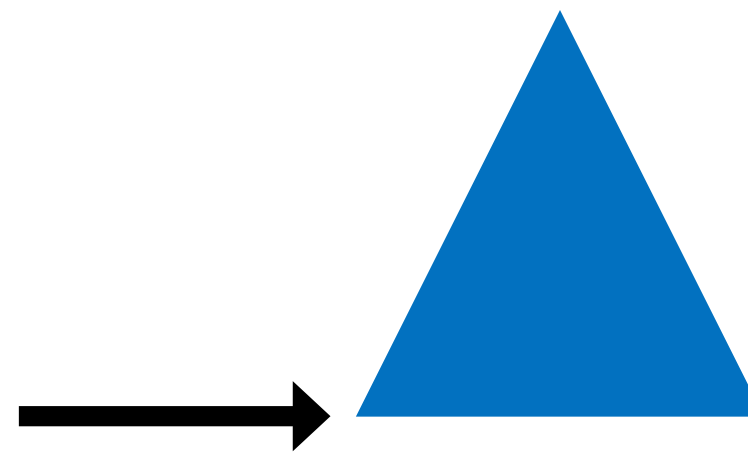
Ring (Poster 1M)

4. to call someone (*verb*)

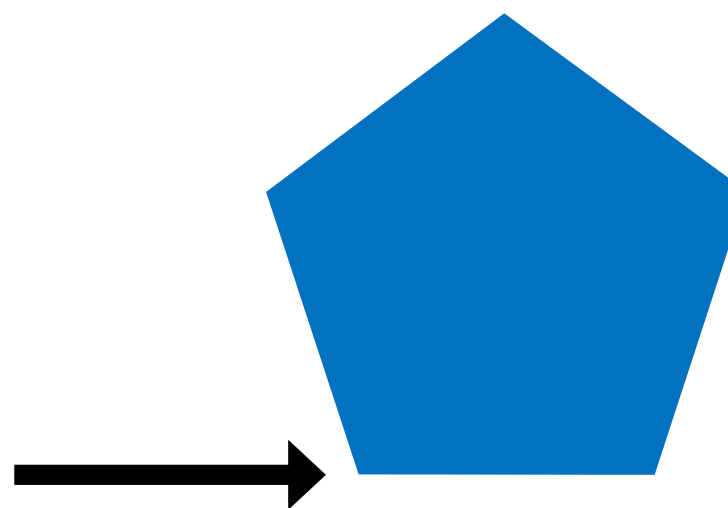

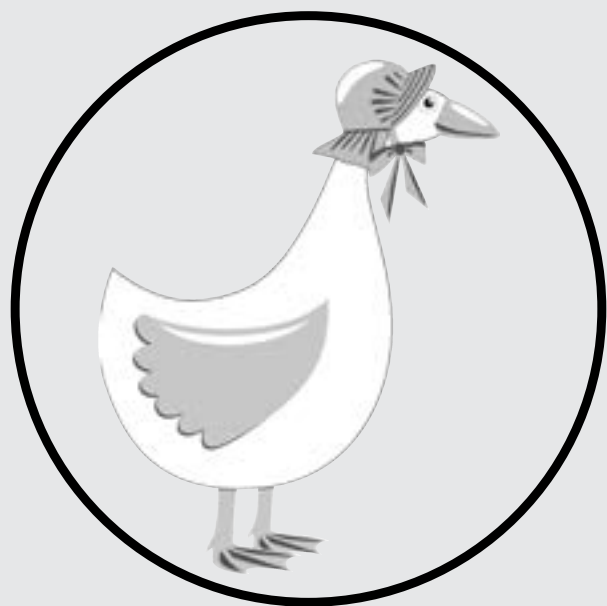

Corner (Poster 2M)

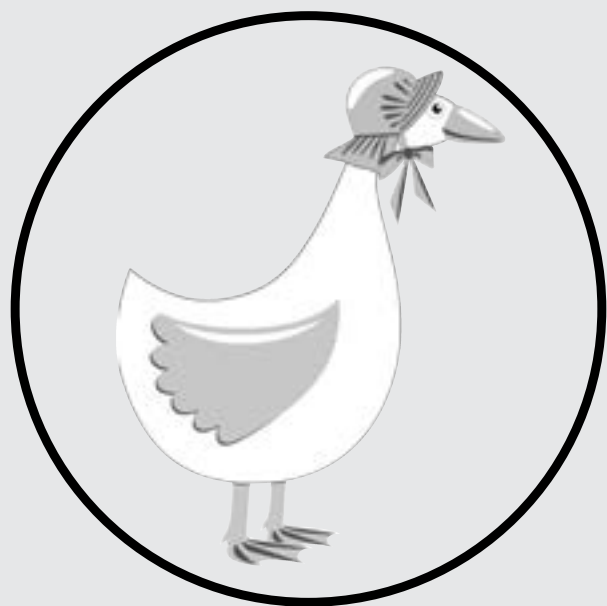
1. a place off to the side (*noun*)
2. where two lines meet or intersect (*noun*)
3. to force a person or animal into a position from which s/he cannot escape (*verb*)

1. the top of the head (*noun*)
2. what a king or queen wears; a symbol of power (*noun*)

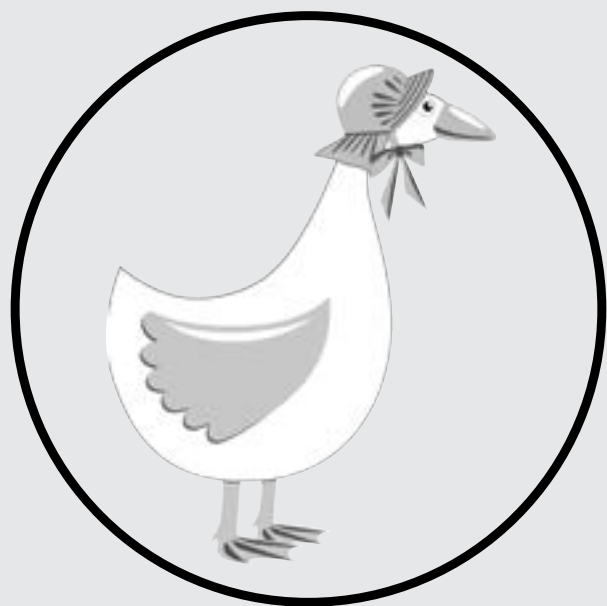

Struck (Poster 4M)

1. the clock indicating a certain time (*verb*)
2. to hit with the hand or object (*verb*)
3. struck out: to miss the ball three times while at bat (*verb*)

Blow (Poster 5M)

1. to play an instrument (*verb*)
2. to exhale heavily (*verb*)
3. to move by the wind (*verb/noun*)

1. to fasten (*verb*)
2. something used to link two ends of a belt or strap (*noun*)

2. to make something come apart into pieces (*verb*)
