
## **Exploration guide: Digital Elementary Consultation**

## Step 1: Set up your device for exploration by opening three windows on your screen:

- 1. Navigate to a lesson and click to open the **Digital Elementary Teacher Guide**. Resize the window to fit half the screen as shown in the image below.
- 2. Click Start Class and select a class section. The Presentation tab will appear to the right of the Teacher Guide tab.
- 3. Drag the Presentation tab that appeared to one side of the screen and resize it as shown in the image below. The **Presentation** window will match the image on the left hand side of the Teacher Guide.
- 4. At the bottom right of the Digital Elementary Teacher Guide, click the circle with three dots •••• Select Student preview. The Student View tab will appear to the right of the Teacher Guide.
- 5. Drag the Student View tab that appeared to one side of the screen, below the Presentation window. Resize it so you can see all three windows at the same time. The **Student View** window will match the Presentation window.



## Step 2: Explore to learn more. Some things to try out:

Use the <b>purple arrows</b> to move through the slides on the Teacher Guide. Watch what
happens on the Presentation and Student View windows.
In the Teacher Guide, use the <b>Preview</b> shelf  to skip a few slides ahead. Click Present.
Click the circle with three dots ••• and toggle to turn on <b>Student Navigation</b> . Flip around in a few slides on your Student View window. Then turn Student Navigation off in the Teacher Guide.
Find a slide with an <b>interactive component</b> (notebook page, Sim, Modeling Tool, book) and play around with it on your Presentation window and in the Student View window.
Find a slide that has the <b>View Work</b> option at the top and explore the interface. Note, without real students logged in, you won't see any live work, but you'll still be able to present a
student's pages.
