When you log into assess your 1st grade students you will see the platform starts with NWF. The two lower measures of LNF and PSF will be grayed out. Once you give NWF the screen will change based on the score for NWF - CLS which is your gated measure.

NWF-CLS = gating measure at Grade 1 MOY

If a student scores above benchmark then the measures of LNF and PSF will indicate tested out. <u>Teachers will need to ignore the "tested out" option</u> and give PSF at MOY by just clicking on the measure after finishing NWF, WRF and ORF


Middle of the Year Online Measures

During the middle of the year benchmark window, staff have the ability to assign online measures to students in their classrooms.

Additional Online Measures:

- Kindergarten: Spelling*, Vocabulary
- 1st Grade: Spelling*, Vocabulary
- 2nd Grade: Maze, Spelling*, Vocabulary
- 3rd 6th Grades: Maze, Spelling*, Vocabulary


Note: Spelling is required to activate the Risk Indicator for DIBELS





Steps to Assign Online Measures

- 1. Login to mCLASS Home
- Click on the green Online Assessment Management Tile
- Once inside Online Assessment Management:
 - a. Select your class from the drop down menu
 - b. Assign assessments to your whole class by using the class assign menu on the left hand side of the screen, or assign assessments to individual students by selecting the options underneath the students name
 - c. Selections save automatically
- 4. Click the blue banner to the right for a recorded walk through of the process.






Dyslexia Risk Indicator Reporting Options:
