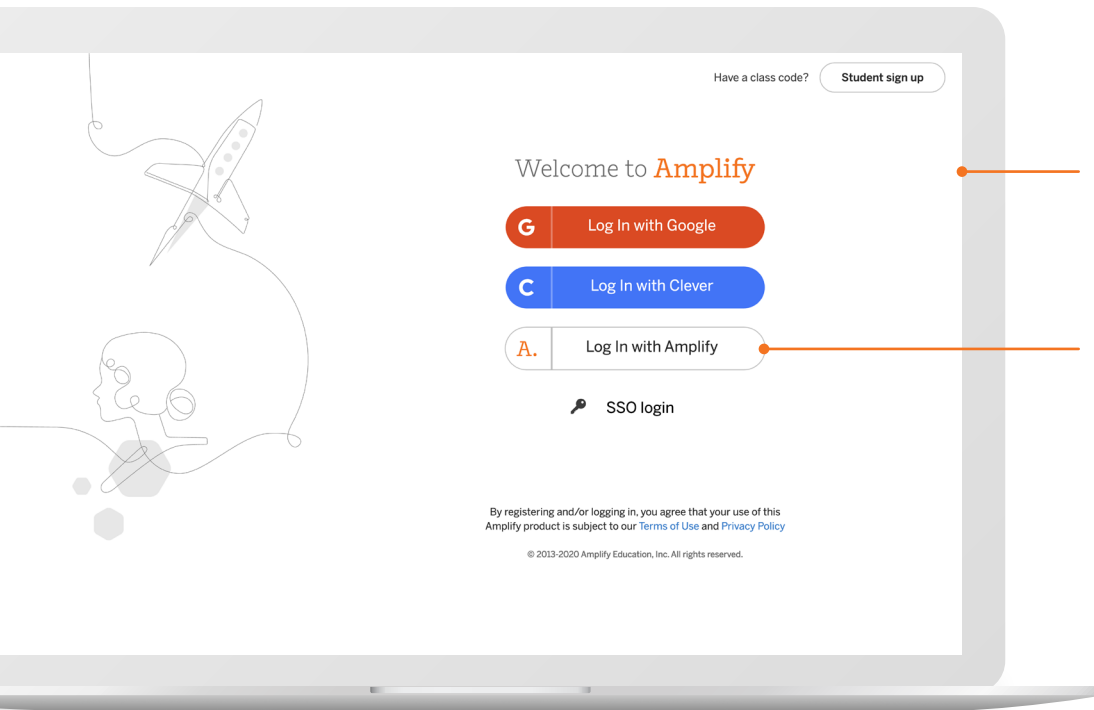

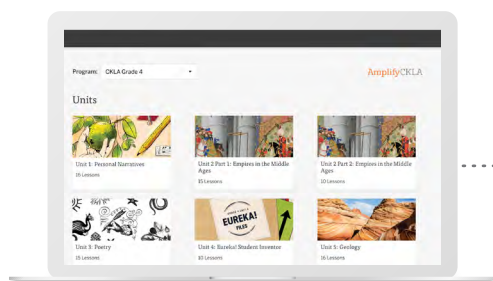

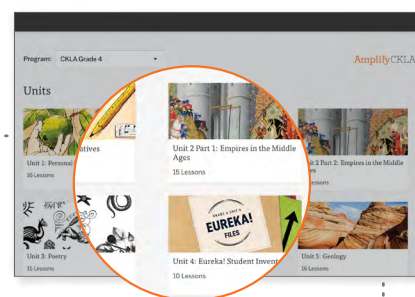
Program structure

Digital navigation (Teacher)



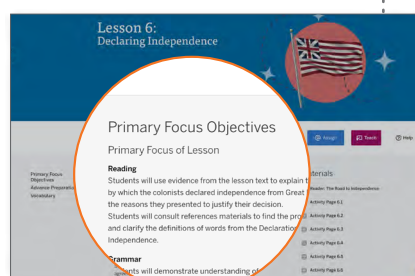

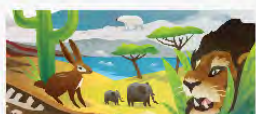

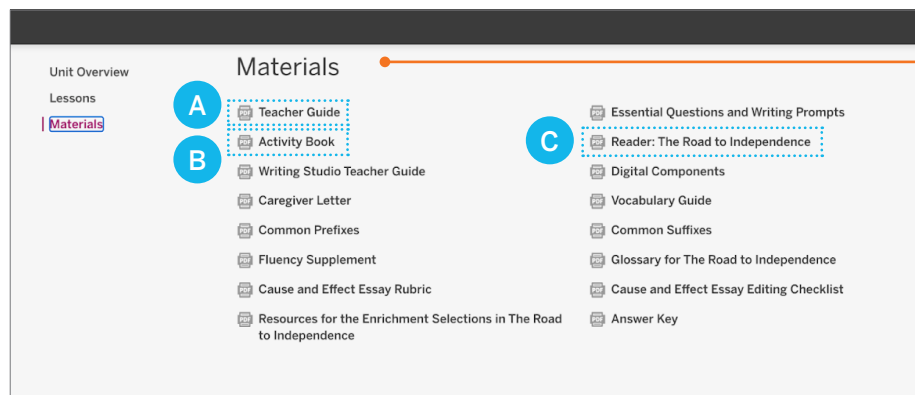
1. Go to **Grade 4** using the dropdown menu.

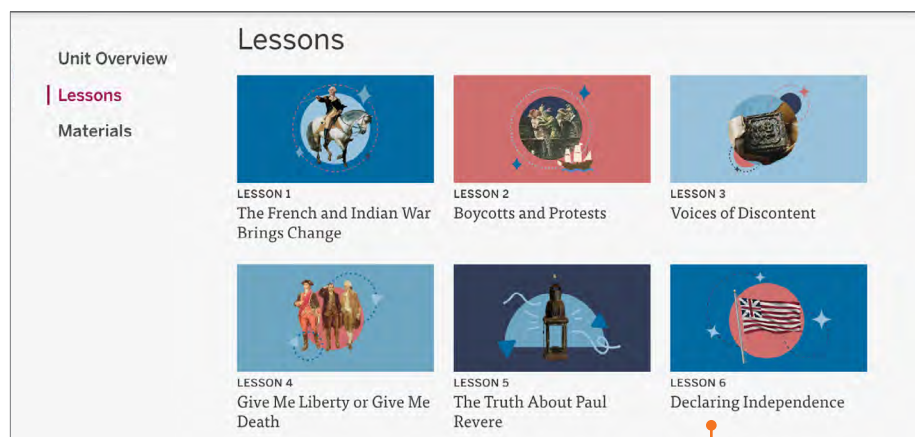

Primary Focus of Lesson

Reading
Students will use evidence from the lesson text to explain the process by which the colonists declared independence from Great Britain and the reasons they presented to justify their decision. Students will consult references materials to find the pronunciations and clarify the definitions of words from the Declaration of Independence.

Grammar
Students will demonstrate understanding of subject-action verb agreement in the present tense.
