
In Grades K-2, the program is divided into two strands: Skills and Knowledge. Both strands are accessible on the Year Overview page.


1. Go to Grade 4 using the dropdown menu.


2. Click on Unit 7: American Revolution.




3. Click Read more to read the Introduction and unit topic.
