### **Literacy Growth and Benchmark Data**


In this section, educators can toggle between growth data and benchmark data.

Literacy Growth: The monthly reading assessment called Curioso Skill Scan provides reading growth and risk data. The literacy growth column identifies students at various levels of literacy development.

Benchmark Data: Boost Reading's embedded benchmark assessment provides student proficiency data at the beginning, middle, and end of the school year, keeping educators informed of critical literacy levels within the classroom.


### Students: Overview

The Students: Overview page leads you to rich data on students' usage, subskill mastery, goal progress, and performance within the program. From here, you can see your class roster at large, then dive deep into Student Detail View. You can also access all the core data you need to drive effective enrichment support on a single platform.



### Students: Skill View

The Students: Skill View provides an overview of where students are placed across the 13 literacy domains. From here, you can stay on top of classroom trends easily and note skill areas to revisit in the classroom as a whole.




### Class Settings

In the Class Settings view, you have control of every student's Boost Reading experience.

Key functions include:

- **1. Boost Reading voiceover**: Support the literacy journey of English learners with voiceover assistance in Spanish.
- **2. Student login**: Easily get students back on track with password reset and additional login methods.
- 3. Practice mode: Allow students to play any level of any game for extra skill practice.
- **4. Caregiver Report**: Download a report that shares student progress with caregivers and families. (Learn more on page 21.)




### Student Detail View

Individual Student Detail View insights are accessible by selecting student names throughout any view on the Teacher Dashboard. These individual student views provide you with an up-close understanding of where every student is on their Boost Reading path.

#### **Usage & Activity**

You can access data on your students' daily Boost Reading engagement and help them meet their weekly usage targets with the Usage and Attendance Calendar, and easily track which Quests and skill games they're working through with the Current Quest indicator.

### Student Detail View: Performance


The Student Detail View's Performance tab combines benchmark and growth data to show a true student literacy story up close.

#### **Benchmark Data**

Students take the Boost Reading Benchmark Assessment, which automatically places them in the program's learning map, at the beginning, middle, and end of the school year. The benchmark data shows reading proficiency throughout the entire year against grade-level expectations (i.e., Above Proficient, Proficient, Well Below Proficient, etc.), including individual fluency and comprehension scores.


#### Growth

The monthly Curioso Skill Scan within Boost Reading briefly assesses growth over time, without impacting student engagement. You'll have access to literacy growth data as the school year progresses, which you can use to further tailor instruction during enrichment and small-group activities.




### Student Detail View: Personalized Path

The Personalized Path tab provides an inside view of skill domains students will encounter throughout the year. Through the Personalized Path view, you can watch as students progress through their subskills and work to meet their literacy goals.



### Student Detail View: Trouble Spots

Navigate over to the Trouble Spots tab for a list of current and past subskills that may have been difficult for students. Skills not mastered will be presented to students again and highlighted for teachers with instructional resources for additional support.

- Comprehensive data: mCLASS benchmark and Boost Reading data are accessible side by side on one platform in the Students: Overview section and Student Detail View.



### Students: Overview with mCLASS data


If you're using mCLASS assessment, you'll see DIBELS composite scores in the Teacher Dashboard's Students: Overview section. The DIBELS 8th Edition Composite Score is important for identifying a student's overall risk for reading difficulty. This data is located in the Performance column next to Skill Scan metrics, so you can easily compare and keep track of student proficiency data alongside monthly growth and risk data for the most comprehensive view of student performance.

Students' mCLASS benchmark scores can be used to sort your class list.



### Individual student performance and mCLASS data

mCLASS composite scores for beginning, middle, and end of year also appear in the Student Detail View in the Performance tab. Together, Boost Reading and mCLASS take on the heavy lifting of analyzing data; targeting specific skills highlighted by mCLASS data; and giving students the exact enrichment, remediation, or intervention support they need.



The mCLASS measures are predictive of long-term reading success. With Boost Reading, students receive direct practice in the key skills needed to grow in mCLASS benchmarks.

## Caregiver Reports

Boost Reading's Caregiver Reports allow you to welcome caregivers into their student's reading journey. Reports shows caregivers their student's level of engagement within the program and how they're performing and progressing toward grade-level literacy goals.




# Administrator Reports

Boost Reading's Administrator Reports provide data insights into engagement, progress, and performance to help administrators make informed decisions at the school and district level.





Boost Reading's Administrator Reports provide real-time, actionable student, class, and school usage and retention information.




### Progress and mastery
