Answers will vary, but may include the term push factors, and may include examples such as having no jobs or money, being hungry, or being unable to speak their minds in their home country.

3. Why did many immigrants settle in large cities?

Answers will vary, but may include that there were more jobs in the cities and earlier immigrants often helped newcomers find jobs.

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4. What does it mean to be a citizen of the United States of America?

Answers will vary, but may include that you are given rights by the U.S. government and have responsibilities that go along with those rights.

5. Name one right and one responsibility held by U.S. citizens.

Answers will vary, but may include rights such as the right to vote, right to a fair trial, right to free speech, right to religious freedom, etc.; and responsibilities such as obeying the law, not doing things that could hurt others, paying taxes, etc.
