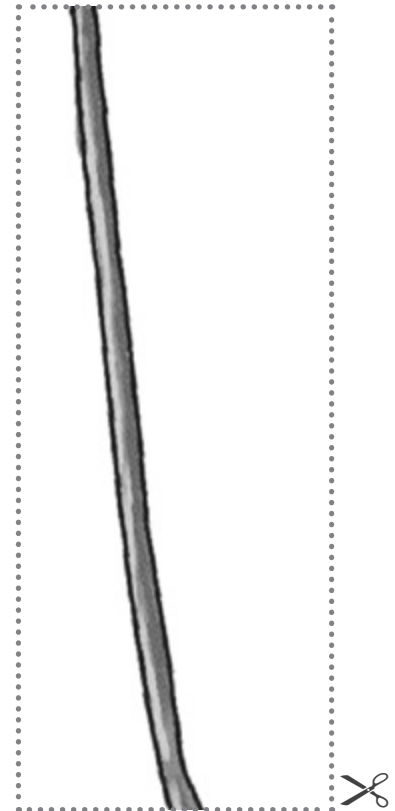
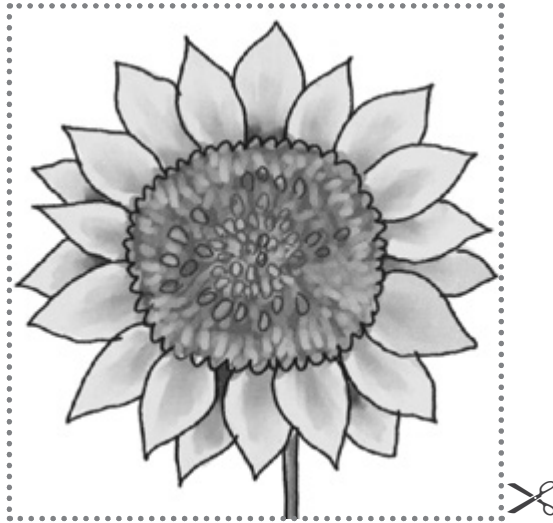

Directions: The activity page shows the parts of a plant. Cut out and paste the parts to make a whole plant.



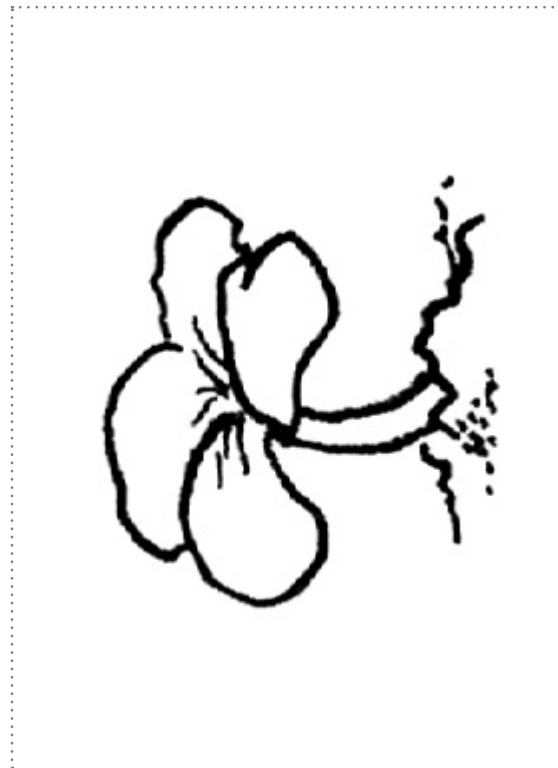
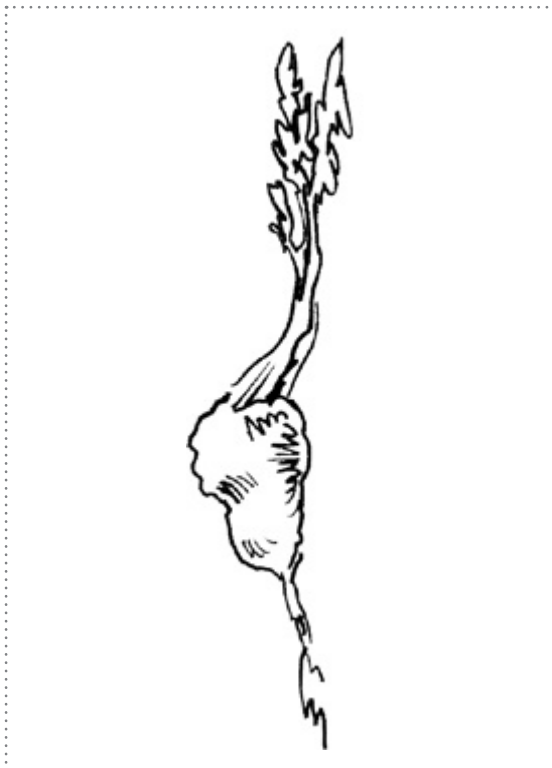
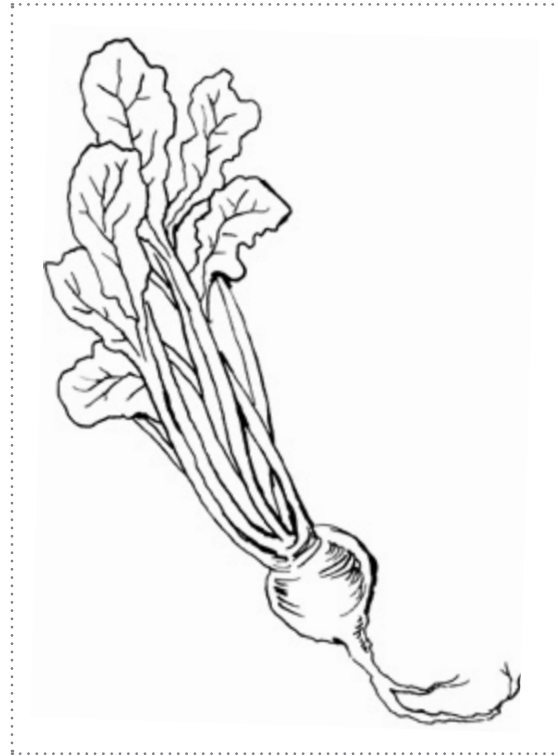
